## INDICATIONS

Hormone-free growth stimulant for improved body mass gain and feed conversion in cattle of any age and any sex in feedlots and on good grazing plus supplement. Replacement heifers should be implanted between 1 and 7 months of age.

## COMPOSITION

Each pellet contains: Zeranol 12 mg (73,8 % *m/m*). Each implant contains: Zeranol 36 mg (3 pellets).

## STORAGE

Store in a cool place.

## WARNINGS

- Withdrawal period: None
- Do not use implant area for human or animal consumption.
- Do not use in breeding bull replacements.
- Implant pellets on the back of the ear only.
- Avoid crushing of pellets.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE - USE ONLY AS DIRECTED

#### **DOSAGE**: 36 mg (1 implant i.e. 3 pellets)

#### Administration via the Ralogun<sup>®</sup>

Insert the cartridge (with the large hollow axle facing to the back i.e. toward the pistol grip) until it snaps into place.

Always use a sharp needle. A blunt needle tears tissue and makes proper implanting difficult.

Wipe the intended puncture site on the backside of the ear with a piece of cotton or gauze moistened with rubbing alcohol.

Insert the needle of the Ralogun<sup>®</sup> under the loose skin and above the cartilage on the back side of the ear. After the needle has been inserted its full length under the skin the point of the needle should reach into the pocket

under the loose skin near the base of the ear. In this area you can pick up the skin with your fingertips.

N.B. Avoid damage to blood vessels and cartilage.

Squeeze the trigger of the Ralogun<sup>®</sup> to deliver the full dose of **Ralgro<sup>®</sup> Cattle Implants**. Keep the trigger depressed while withdrawing the needle to be sure that **Ralgro<sup>®</sup> Cattle Implants** remains in position.

Wipe the needle with cotton or gauze moistened with alcohol or other suitable disinfectant. Do not dip the needle in solution as it could clog the needle.

Rotate cartridge in direction indicated by the arrow until a new dose is visible and centered in window. The Ralogun<sup>®</sup> is now ready for next implantation.
