

PLANNING FARM VISITS

- Ensure permission from relevant person is obtained prior to visiting the farm
- Vehicles should be clean and disinfected before leaving for a farm visit
- Pack proper supplies to maintain biosecurity which include;
 1. Clean PPE's
 2. Clean disinfected rubber boots
 3. Clean instruments and equipment
 4. Bucket, soap, boot brush
 5. Disposable gloves
 6. Nail Brush
 7. Trash Bags
 8. Sharps Bin

PRODUCTS

1. F10SC Veterinary Disinfectant (diluted 1:100) OR F10CL General Farm Disinfectant (diluted 1:20)
2. F10SCXD Veterinary Disinfectant (diluted 1:100)
3. F10 Sterilant with Rust Inhibitor (RTU)
4. F10 Aerosol Fogger (RTU)
5. F10 Hand Scrub / F10 Antiseptic Liquid Soap (RTU – water required)
6. F10 Hand Gel / Rub / Foam (RTU – no water required)

VEHICLES

- Park vehicles on paved / concrete areas away from farm production sites. On arrival back at the practice, park and unload vehicle in designated area only.
- Ensure that tyres and chassis are free of dirt and debris by hosing down and spraying with diluted **F10SC Veterinary Disinfectant** or **F10CL General Farm Disinfectant** before leaving the premises.
- Remove contaminated clothing before entering your vehicle and place dirty clothing in a plastic bag.
- Make use of the **F10 Aerosol Fogger** for interior disinfection of the vehicle.
- Take precautions to ensure the inside of the vehicle remains clean so that clothes, clean overalls and equipment do not become contaminated.
- Remove plastic floor mats, scrub with **F10SCXD Veterinary Disinfectant Cleanser** and rinse. Spray with **F10SC Veterinary Disinfectant** or **F10SC General Farm** and leave to dry.
- Wash and disinfect all vehicles - exterior as well as interior thoroughly once a week.

TIP: Designate a space inside the vehicle (area or container) as "clean" and keep clean supplies, clothing and boots in this area.

Also designate a "dirty" area/container to store and dispose of dirty clothing and equipment

FOOTWEAR

- Before leaving the site, clean and disinfect boots or tightly bag boots to be cleaned later.
- Scrub boot bottom and sides with **F10 Hand Scrub** or **F10 Antiseptic Liquid Soap** and water to remove all dirt and debris.
- Rinse with clean water. Spray with **F10SC Veterinary Disinfectant** or **F10CL General Farm Disinfectant** and leave to dry.
- Avoid stepping into vehicle with dirty, contaminated footwear.

TIP: All disinfectants are to an extend in-activated by dirt, manure or other organic matter – always clean first!



CLOTHING

- Wear clean overalls that are free of organic debris and are freshly laundered daily.
- It is sometimes necessary to visit and examine animals at different locations on the same day. Clean protective clothing should be worn for each visit!
- Launder all overalls and clothing at the end of each day. Pre-soak in **F10SCXD Veterinary Disinfectant Cleanser** for 30 minutes before regular washing. Sun or tumble dry.

HAND HYGIENE

- Thoroughly wash hands with **F10 Hand Scrub** or **F10 Antiseptic Liquid Soap** and water *before entering* and *after leaving* any animal facility.
- Dry hands with paper towel and discard.
- If not visibly soiled, hands may be decontaminated using waterless agents such as **F10 Hand Gel / Rub / Foam**.

EQUIPMENT

- Remove only the equipment that will be used during the visit from the vehicle.
- Equipment and instruments that have been in direct animal contact must be cleaned and disinfected after use and maintained
- in such a way that they do not become re-contaminated. Wash with **F10SCXD Veterinary Disinfectant** and rinse, dry.
- Between cases, spray all utensils, equipment, instruments with **F10SC Veterinary Disinfectant** or **F10CL General Farm** and leave to dry.
- If sterilizing of instruments is required, submerge clean instruments in a solution of **F10 Cold Sterilant with Rust Inhibitor** for 10 minutes. No need to rinse.
- No dirty paper, gloves or other disposable items are to be returned to the practice or transported to another farm.
- Seal these items in a trash bag for convenient and safe disposal by the farmer (burn).

NOTES:

1. **F10SC Veterinary Disinfectant** may be applied by hand spray, foaming or fogging, depending on application
2. Fogging should be done with **F10SC Veterinary Disinfectant** at a dilution of 1:250 (4 ml / l potable water) through an ULV Fogger or backpack/garden sprayer
